STATEMENT BY CHAIR JOSEPH M. MCNAMARA ON VOTER REGISTRATION EFFORTS

“This Presidential election will be one of the most important elections in recent history. You cannot have a voice in the direction this country will take - including its Congress, Supreme Court and Presidency - unless you vote, and you can't do that unless you are registered to vote.

Our state Democratic Party has been heavily promoting voter registration information and encouraging residents to do so. In fact, this Sunday is the deadline to register to vote in the upcoming Presidential Preference Primary on April 26, and I continue to urge everyone - Democrat or not - to exercise the privilege so many people across the globe do not enjoy.

In terms of online voter registration, our Secretary of State has been working with our General Assembly and Governor to make it easier for people to register to vote, but that is still legislation in process and it has not yet been finalized,” said Chair Joseph M. McNamara.
