**R.I. DEMOCRATIC PARTY HOSTING ELECTION NIGHT WATCH -PARTY AT HISTORIC BILTMORE HOTEL  
*State Party Headquarters to Serve as Central Site on Election Day***

Democrats Calling for Volunteer Drivers & Voters Needing Rides to the Polls to Contact HQs at 401.272.3367; Voter Protection Unit to Provide Statewide Assistance

**WARWICK, R.I.** – Rhode Island Democratic Party Chair Joseph M. McNamara announced today that the state Party offices, at 200 Metro Center Blvd. in Warwick, will serve as the central location for Election Day activities. The headquarters will be used to coordinate rides to the polls, offer voter protection assistance, and statewide GOTV (Get Out the Vote) for federal and state candidates.

Volunteers looking to help that day with driving voters to the polls, door-knocking and phone-banking, should call the offices at **401.272.3367** to sign up: **that same number will be the official number voters can call for any Election Day concerns.**

Congressman James Langevin will be using the headquarters for his final Election Day push. Party officials will work with Congressman David Cicilline's campaign through his three statewide sites (Providence, Newport and Woonsocket.)

In the evening, Chair McNamara invites all Rhode Islanders to join him at the Biltmore Hotel Garden Room for the election results. Media are invited and will be provided a walk-through of the facilities prior to Election night (media alert to follow.) Doors will open to the public at 6:30 P.M. with elected officials and candidates speaking from 7:45 P.M. on. U.S. Senators Jack Reed and Sheldon Whitehouse, Congressmen Langevin and Cicilline, Governor Gina Raimondo, and all state officers and Democratic mayors are invited and expected to attend.
